5. COVID-19 Requirements:

Take a COVID-19 PCR test before initiating travel, upload the PCR negative certificate on Trusted Travel either through PANABIOS or Global Haven platform and present TT or TC codes to Port Health authorities in Kenya to access your COVID-19 PCR

test result within 72 hours after sample collection.

Trusted travel is a platform that facilitates authentication of COVID-19 test certificates through coding of test results with trusted travel (TT) codes and travel codes (TC). Travelers from countries already onboard the Trusted Travel platform get tested by trusted laboratories already enrolled in the system. After taking a COVID-19 PCR test, the traveler must register on www.PanaBIOS.com, then receive a system generated message from PanaBIOS with information about the issuance of a trusted traveler (TT) code.

6. Airport Transfers:

KenTrade will arrange for airport transfers upon request prior to arrival.

7. Entry Requirements:

The Kenyan government requires that all delegates be in possession of a valid Passport or similar authentic travel document that is not less than six months, the Yellow Fever Vaccine certificate and a return ticket.

8. Tourist Site Visits:

Mombasa has some historical /tourist attraction/sites that delegates can register to

visit:

a) Fort Jesus

One of the most visited tourist attractions in Mombasa (Old Mombasa Town) built by

the Portuguese in the 16th century. Mombasa was a transit place for trade at that time

and a gateway to India, and the Fort Jesus was built to protect the town from outside

invaders.

The charges are as follow:

Option I:

Bus tours along Coast of Mombasa for 3 hours, soft drinks and snacks with provided.

Dhow (boat ride) from Tamarind dock station for 2 hours, lunch and soft drink

provided on board. Fort Jesus sound and light show with fireworks. Dinner and non-

alcoholic drinks will be provided. Ksh. 9,500/= (Min 20 Pax)

Option 2:

Fort Jesus (Tour Only):

I. Residents: \$10

II. Non-residents: \$20

b) Mama Ngina Drive (The Waterfront)

c) Elephant Tusks

At the heart of Mombasa lies the iconic elephant tusks which are among landmarks

that represent the city. The tusks are famous because of their history and the many things that they symbolize and represent. They were initially commissioned to commemorate the visit of Princess Margaret (Queen Elizabeth's sister) in 1956, when Kenya was still part of the British Empire. The tusks are meant to represent the entrance to the city of Mombasa and were therefore to welcome Princess Margaret for her visit.

9. Currency Regulation:

Foreign exchange facilities are available at the Airport and in Kenya through "Bureau de Change" (Forex Bureau) all days of the week during normal trading hours.

Banks are open as from Monday to Friday from 09:00 am to 4:00 pm and on Saturday from 09:00 am to 12:00 pm

One can use the Visa Card or Master Card to access his/her bank account through ATM and/or PDQ Machines (where necessary) to make payments for services rendered or goods bought.
